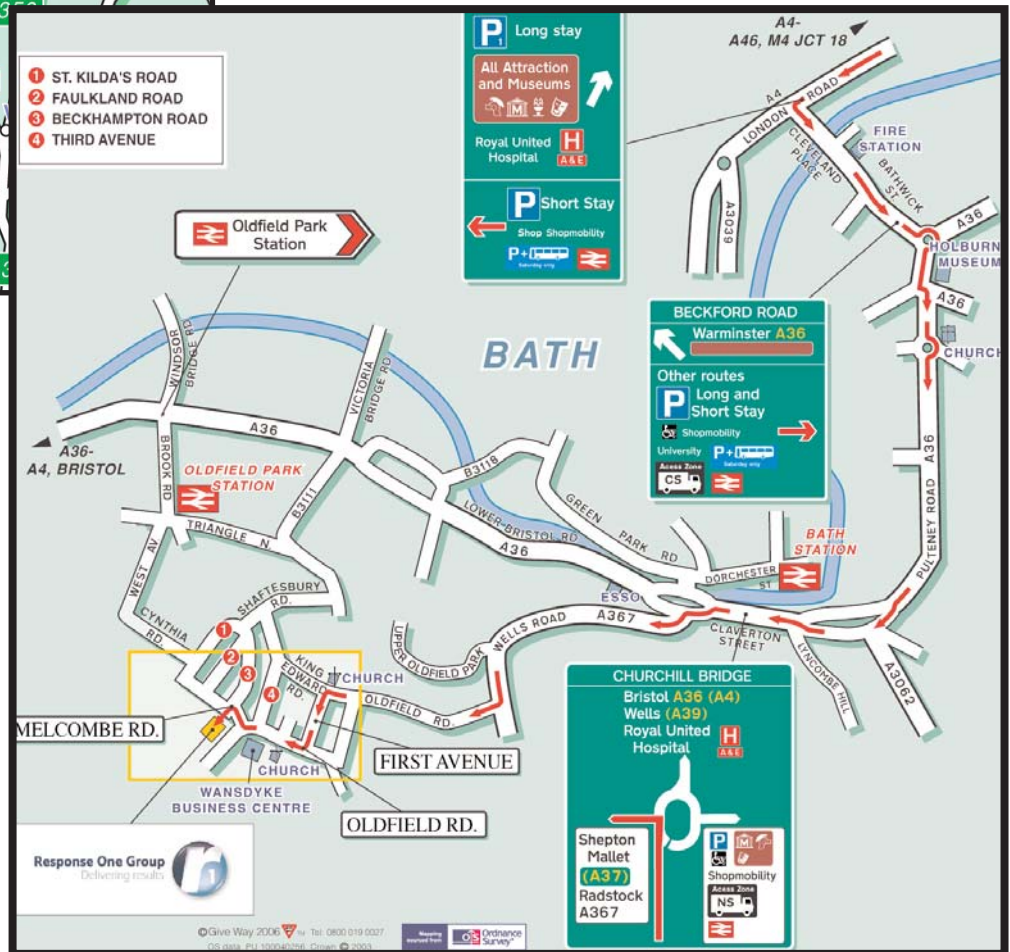

DIRECTIONS TO THE OLD DAIRY
FROM THE M4



By car

Take **J18 to Bath off the M4**. Continue into Bath on A46. You will enter Bath on the London Road– **continue in the left-hand lane**. At the lights (The London Road Stores is on the corner) turn left onto **Cleveland Place** – you will go over a bridge and onto Bathwick Street. Pass the Fire Station on your left and a row of shops on your right (incl. The Barley pub).

At the Traffic lights turn right onto Darlington Street. Pass the Holbourne Museum on your left, as you approach the next roundabout you will pass a church (St Mary the Virgin). **At this Roundabout take the second exit (straight over) onto Pulteney Road**. Stay in the left-hand lane and go straight on. **Follow the sign towards Wells (A37)**.

Go through the traffic lights and under the bridge. You will pass The Royal Oak Pub, The Golden Fleece Pub and a school on your right. Towards the end of this road you will come to a bridge.

Follow the road around to the right and you will be on Widcombe High Street (shops on both sides and a pub called The Ram to your right). Stay in the left-hand lane marked Wells and go straight on. As the traffic merges from beneath the railway bridge, **take the sharp turning to your left (following the sign post to Shepton Mallet (A37))**.

You will now be on the **Wells Road**. Follow this road up (approx. half a mile). As the road curves around to the left you will see a B&B called Leighton House to your left, which has a clear white sign post on the roadside, drive on a few meters further. As the road bends to the left take a sharp **turn to your right onto Oldfield Road**. Follow this down and you will see a sign for Moorland Road Local Shops, follow the road down passing Cedar Park Care Centre.

Turn left down First Avenue. Follow the road to the end and **turn right at the bottom onto Oldfield Lane**. You will pass a church on the left called Catholic Church of Our Lady and St. Alphege. Pass the Wansdyke Business Centre on your left and follow the road to the end.

At the end of the road you will see a hardware store called Grahams **Turn left onto Melcombe Road** and at the top you will see a red brick building called The Old Dairy.

By train

The nearest major train station is **Bath Spa**. Taxis are available outside. Allow 10-15 minutes travel.
